START!!!

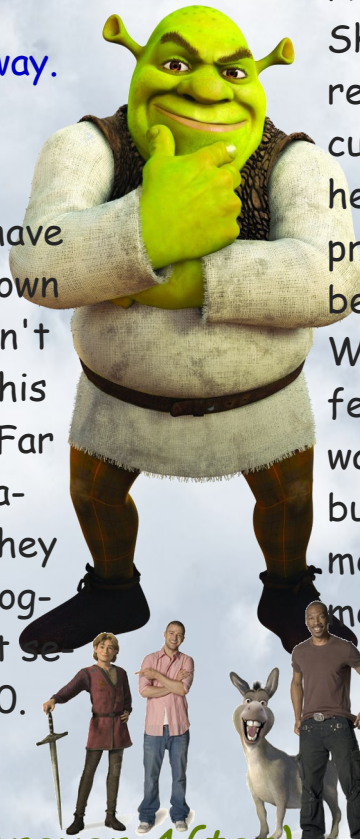
~Somebody help! I've been kidnapped by a monster who's trying to relate to me!

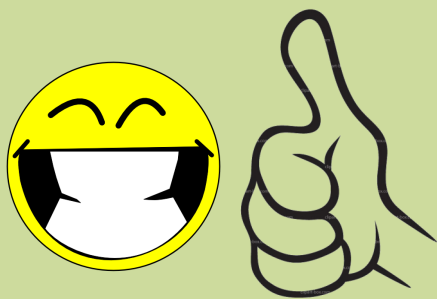
- On your mobile - the best way to do it is write the most important things for the test in memo.

- Only write important words on your test card using very soft pencil. But remember you must rub it out before you give back your test.

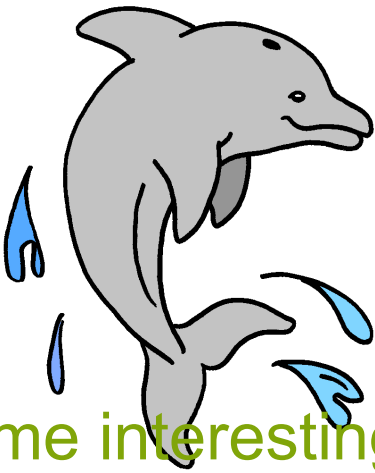

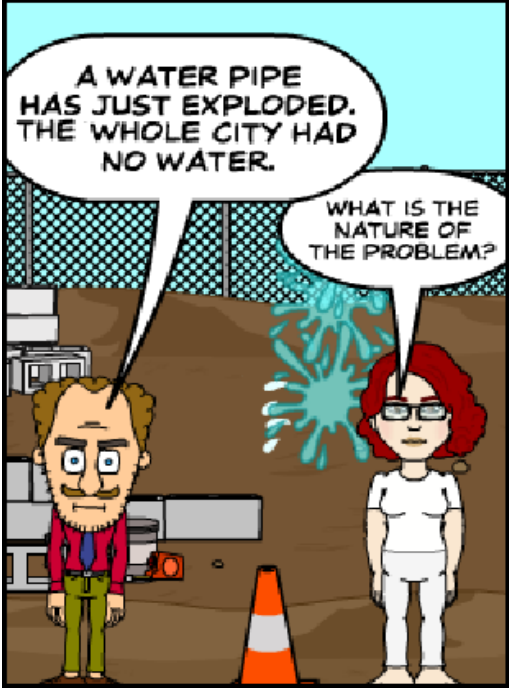

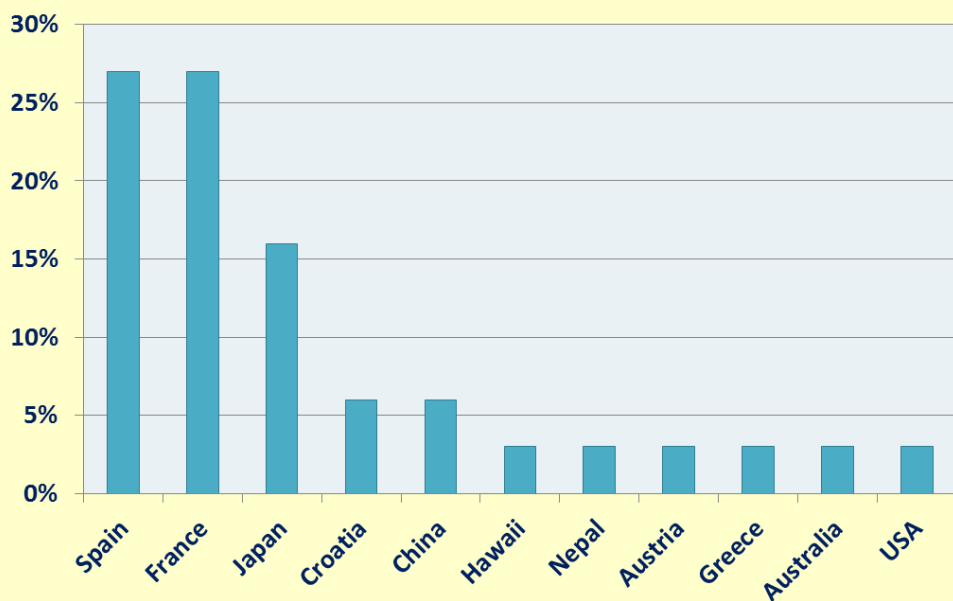
