Interesting facts about winter

- 1.** Earth is closest to the sun during winter. Distance from the sun is not what causes the seasons, but it affects the length of them.
- 2.** The lowest temperature ever recorded in the United Kingdom is $-27,2^{\circ}$ Celsius . The same temperature occurred there twice.
- 3.** Wet snow – snow that sticks together, it falls in a temperature slightly warmer than 0°C . Physics confirm that it is perfect for building a snowman!
- 4.** Every 12cm of snow would provide 1cm of water.
- 5.** Chionophobia is a fear of snow.
- 6.** Winters in Russia are so cold that they used them for defense during wars. Instead of peaceful negotiations with France, tsar Alexander I left Bonaparte to deal with cold.
- 7.** No country in the Southern Hemisphere has hosted, or has ever applied to host the Winter Olympics.
- 8.** Snowflakes usually form unique patterns, but there's an instance of identical snow crystals. In 1988, two snowflakes collected from a Wisconsin storm were confirmed to be the same.

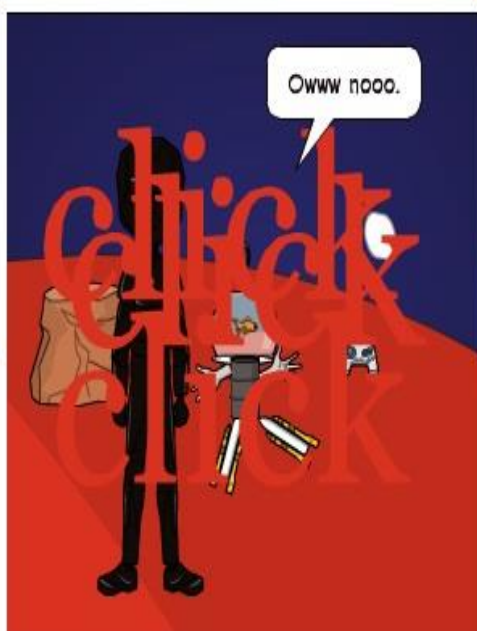
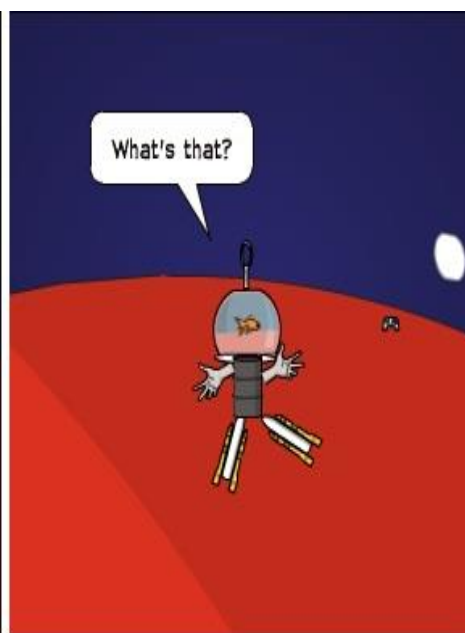
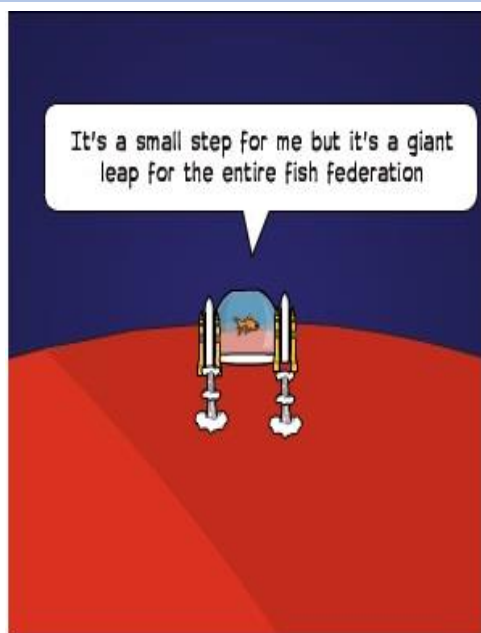
The Christmas is near

Feeling sugar in their brains



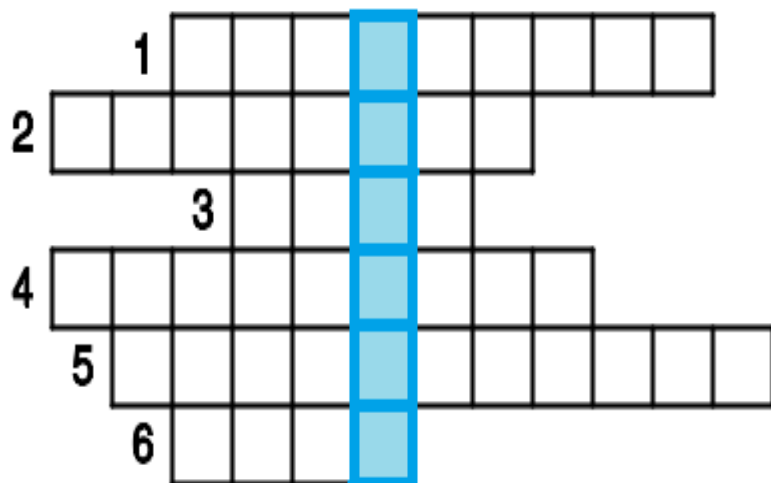
Ornaments hang on the tree

No one here is scrappy.



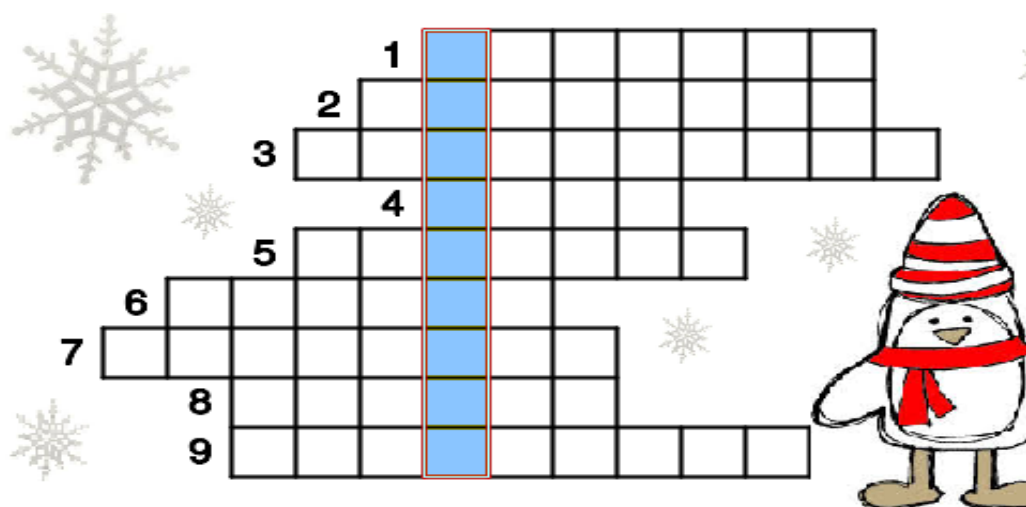

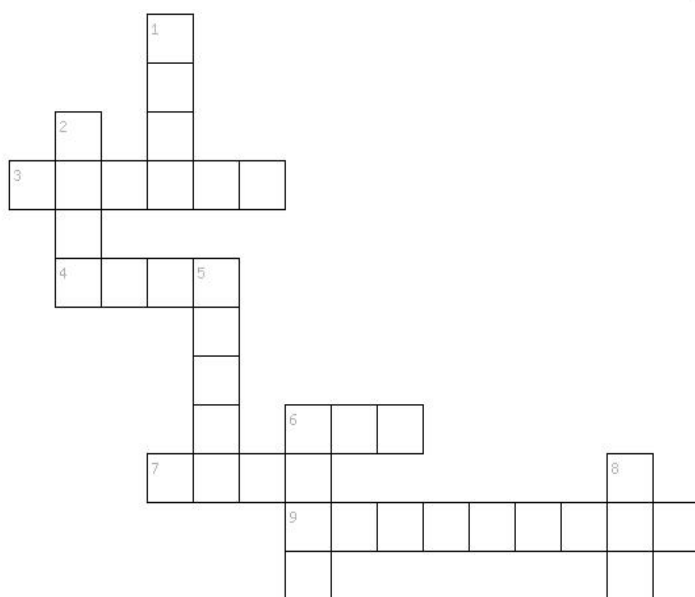
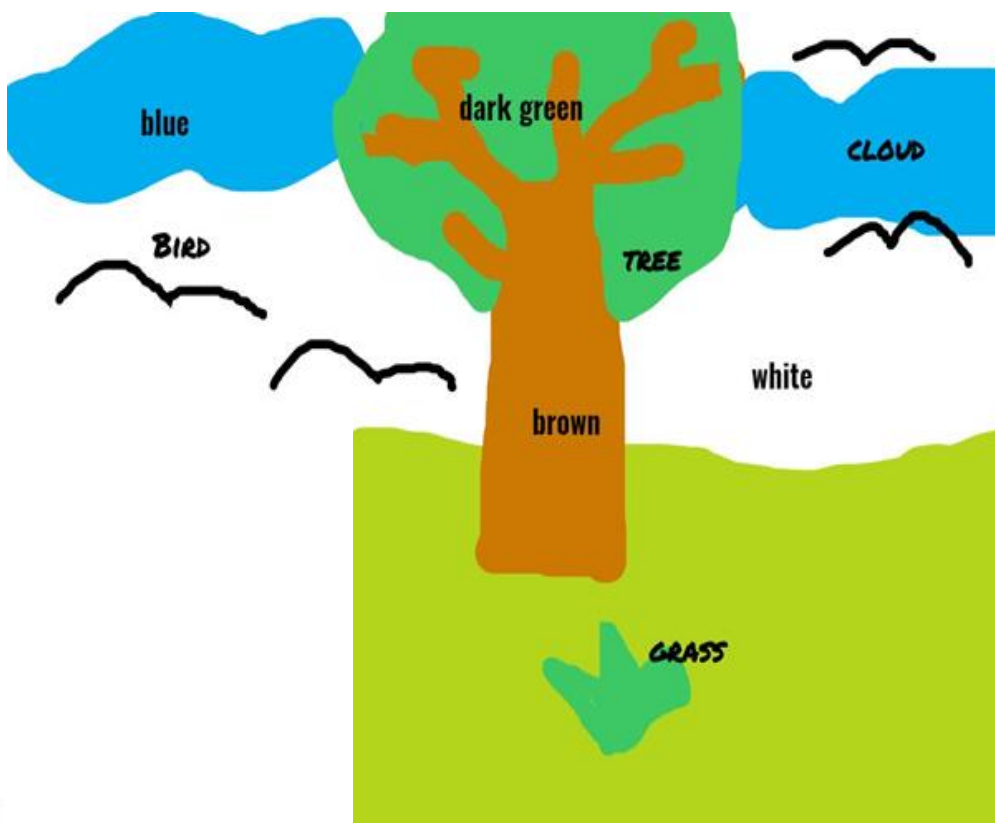
